SAFE CHILD THAILAND - You may know that a small group of Parishioners subscribe/donate to Safe Child Thailand. A yearly subscription helps support a young boy with the necessities - food and housing, school uniform and the like. He lives in a home with other children. Each year, we get an update on our boy, known as Bible (a pseudonym) who is 9 years old, and it is a pleasure to read of his progress and see how he has grown in a photograph. The organisation was founded in 1982, inspired by a Catholic priest, Fr.Ray Brennan, whose work raised awareness of the plight of orphans and abandoned babies in one area of Thailand. Now nationwide, their work has grown, supporting homes, schools and safe houses for children, and projects focussed on healthcare, education, child protection, anti-trafficking and family and community empowerment. Our Parish group is small, and it would help this hard-working organisation if we were able to send them more financial support. The sub/donation is paid annually, and will be £15 per year.
