PARISH EVENTS AND INFORMATION

This Weekend: The great feast of the Epiphany when we celebrate the child born of Mary who is the manifestation of the one who is the Son of God, the Messiah and Light of the Nations.

Christmastide continues until next weekend with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, after which we enter into Ordinary Time. As is traditional, our crib scenes remain in Church until the end of Christmastide, and you can still make donations there to our Diocesan Children's Society.

At Epiphany Masses, dates of movable feasts for the upcoming year were often announced after the Gospel. Instead of this, but in the same spirit, here is the text of the proclamation for you to take home with you.

'Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Saviour:

On the 5th day of March will fall Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the 20th day of April, you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Holy Passover of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the 29th day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the 8th day of June, the Feast of Pentecost.

On the 22nd day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the 30th day of November, the First Sunday of Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.'

This Sunday (5th January) 3.00-4.00pm at Penzance. Holy Hour: Come and spend some time with the Lord in quiet prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Benediction will then be celebrated at 3.45pm. Come for the whole hour, or just a few minutes.

Afterwards, refreshments will be available in the Hall. Hot drinks & some seasonal nibbles!
