Ascension Day is a Holy Day when we all ought to try and be at Mass. Vigil Mass in Hayle 7 p.m. on Wednesday. On the day itself St Ives, Mass at 12 noon, and Penzance 10 a.m. and Solemn Mass at 7.30 p.m.

The Nine Days (Novena) between Ascension and Pentecost are days of Prayer for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Begin each day invoking the Holy Spirit using St Pope John XXIII's prayer:

Renew your wonders in this our day, as by a new Pentecost. Grant to your Church, that being of one mind and steadfast in prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus, and following the lead of Blessed Peter, it may advance the reign of our Divine Saviour, the reign of truth and justice, the reign of love and peace. Amen.
