COVID-19 Route Map Step 4 Guidance: Life is still very uncertain, as local news keeps telling us, with **Cornwall remaining very high on the list**, so we continue to **PROCEED WITH CAUTION**. So, step by step, we are seeking that conversion of heart which is so necessary to recognise more fully God as Creator of all that is, and our responsibility to exercise sensitive stewardship of the earth which the Lord has entrusted to us.
