Moving ahead as a Parish: Thank you to everyone who came to our recent gatherings in all our mainland Churches. Lots of ideas were generated and the following way forward proposed:

Lent & Easter:

A time of reflection, repentance, preparation and celebration of our faith as individuals and as a parish.

May:

A whole Parish meeting sharing facts; figures & ideas.

June:

Fr Paul will appoint a finance committee to support him in his stewardship of all parish finances.

People will be asked to volunteer to form a Parish Action Group to provide opportunities for our Parish to come together and grow through activities and stronger structures.

Small groups at Hayle and St Ives will be formed to look at the 'fabric' of these churches. A similar group will be formed in Penzance when the main building works are concluded.

All these groups will operate for one year and then be reviewed.

But for your consideration now is a call for volunteers to lead Stations of the Cross on Wednesday mornings in St Ives; Thursday mornings in Penzance and Friday mornings in Hayle.
