**Reception of Holy Communion under both kinds.** *The Bishops' Conference reminds us that It is important to remember the totality of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the Lord is received in either or both species. The choice of receiving from the chalice is for each communicant to make. They remind us too that **intinction by the communicant is FORBIDDEN in England & Wales.***

We can look at how we moved forward on this in the coming weeks. We will need to think of some additional extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist.

I know many still feel cautious and I remain quite scrupulous about maintaining good hygiene for your altar breads to be consecrated, just as I have been in the distribution of them. That will continue at present.

**'The Peace.'** Be aware of other peoples' feelings in exchanging the peace with physical contact. Weekdays is better just to acknowledge, as walking around is not encouraged. Sunday's I leave to your discretion.

**Pope Francis message to young Catholics** gathered in London for the Flame Congress, 150 days before the 37<sup>th</sup> World Youth Day to be held in Lisbon on 1-6 August 2023 *"Dare to be different and point to ideals other than those of this world, testifying to the beauty of generosity, service, purity, perseverance, forgiveness, fidelity to our personal vocation, prayer, the pursuit of justice and the common good, love for the poor and social friendship."*

The theme of WYD is **"Rise Up"** an echo of Our Lady's response to the angel Gabriel. Rise up as young Catholics for the surprising and beautiful adventure that is our Catholic Faith.

**Children First: newsletter of the Catholic Childrens Society, Plymouth Diocese.** Copies of the Spring issue are in our churches. Do take a copy. They do say: *'We could not continue to do what we do to support vulnerable children and their families living in our Diocese, without the support of our parishes, parishioners, Catholic schools and other loyal supporters. Last year, we were overwhelmed by the number of applications we received to our Essential Grants programme, which we always knew would continue to rise as it has been doing since the start of the pandemic. We received 396 applications compared to 314 in 2021, 219 in 2020 and 178 in 2019 and we envisage the number of families looking to us for our help will only continue to rise as the costs of living are becoming too much. At present we have had to put a maximum limit on the amount of grant funding we can approve each month, as we simply cannot continue to approve the number of requests for support.
