The weekend of 23/24 June is the Nativity of St John the Baptist, which replaces the normal Sunday sequence. The Church only observes three birthdays, all related. John the Baptist, Our Lady (8th September) and of course, Our Lord on 25th December. Jesus said "In truth I tell you, of all children born of women, there has never been anyone greater than John the Baptist." (Matthew 11 v.11)

Safeguarding.
