## ‘Habemus Papam’ – We have a new Pope:

We give thanks for the election of Cardinal Robert Prevost to be Pope Leo XIV. ‘Peace be with you’ were the first words he spoke, and he went on to stress the necessity for building bridges and dialogue.

Canon Paul Cummins, our Diocesan Administrator, has issued a statement on behalf of the Diocese (available at [www.plymouth-diocese.org.uk](http://www.plymouth-diocese.org.uk)) during which he says: ‘God has blessed us with a new shepherd to guide His Church, Pope Leo XIV. This is a moment of pure joy and hope for all of us in the Diocese of Plymouth, in England and Wales, and indeed across the world. Thanks be to God for this great gift.

The election of a Pope is always a significant moment for the Catholic Church, so I invite you to support Pope Leo XIV in his new ministry of service as we join in prayer for him.’
