**The Catholic Church in Penzance: A History 1843-2018** Written by Anne Shipman. 100 pages, some colour pictures. On sale now; a bargain at £15. Anne's lavish book tells the remarkable story of this early-Victorian architectural gem; from its establishment by Irish and French missionaries, as the Catholic religion was emerging from the shadows of the Reformation, through to the modern day, as we celebrate 175 years. It is a vibrant story both of faith and ego, wartime survival, and there's a mysterious body in the crypt. Woven throughout is a cast of fascinating characters including a saint, shipwrecked sailors and even a much-loved pugilist priest.

**History: Province of Southwark.** I know many people were unaware that our Diocese of Plymouth is in the Province of Southwark, under Archbishop Peter. Initially when the Hierarchy was set up in 1850 all dioceses were under Westminster. In 1911 Birmingham and Liverpool were raised as Provinces, with their Bishops raised to Archbishop. Plymouth then came under Birmingham, and some may remember Bishop Francis Grimshaw (Plymouth 1947-1954) became Archbishop of Birmingham 1954-1965. In 1965 Southwark became a province, so Plymouth then became part of Southwark that also includes Arundel & Brighton and Portsmouth. What a joy it was to have our Archbishop Peter on our 175<sup>th</sup>
