Funeral Arrangements: Daily adverts on radio and TV are pushing various matters about funerals. I have always urged parishioners to write down clearly what you want for your funeral and make sure your family know your wishes. A Requiem is the normal Catholic commendation and chose hymns & readings if you have special requests.

The Bishop of Shrewsbury has written a good letter especially noting the "no fuss" funerals/ cremations which seem devised to prevent participation by family, friend or community. I have made a few copies of the Bishop's letter available. On the reverse side I have printed the Works of Mercy which include burying the dead and praying for them. Always ask for a copy if all are gone.

Salina's letter update:

The CAFOD Fix the Food System campaign culminating in Salina's Letter to the World Bank has had results! 70,000 parishioners from 762 parishes supported the letter calling on the World Bank to protect farmers' rights to freely access their traditional seeds. The letters and signatures were delivered to the World Bank's annual meeting in Morocco in October, The World Bank has agreed to meet with CAFOD representatives in both London and Morocco to look at the issue. This is an important step forward in the CAFOD campaign. Thank you all for your support and taking time to understand the issues involved.
