The Glorious Feast of the Ascension of the Lord, is this Thursday. Forty days after the Resurrection 'the Lord was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. (Acts 1:9) It is a Holy Day and we all ought to try and be at Mass that day. Vigil Mass 7pm on Wednesday in Hayle, Penzance 10 a.m. and Sung 7.30 p.m. and St Ives 12 noon.

Our Parish school will have a Procession of Our Lady with a Liturgy of the Word on Tuesday 16th at 9.30 a.m. to mark Our Lady's Month of May. All welcome.

St Eugene de Mazenod his day is 21st May, this Sunday. I will remember him in the Eucharistic Prayer. He was Bishop of Marseilles, founder of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate, and visited Penzance and our church in July 1850.

Novena for Pentecost. Nine days of prayer and reflection from Ascension to Pentecost. Begin each day invoking the Holy Spirit using St Pope John XXIII's prayer:

Renew your wonders in this our day, as by a new Pentecost. Grant to your Church, that being of one mind and steadfast in prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus, and following the lead of Blessed Peter, it may advance the reign of our Divine Saviour, the reign of truth and justice, the reign of love and peace. Amen.
