Season of Creation 2022: Listen to the voice of Creation. With the very high temperatures in July, the lack of rain across UK and Europe: floods elsewhere, all point to the on-going climate change.

"The urgent challenge to protect our common home includes a concern to bring the whole human family together to seek a sustainable and integral development, for we know that things can change. The Creator does not abandon us; he never forsakes his loving plan or repents of having created us." Laudato Si par: 13

The Season of Creation is the annual Christian celebration to listen and respond together to the cry of Creation: it is a time when the ecumenical family around the world unites to pray and protect our common home. The Season begins on the 1st September, the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and ends on the 4th October, the Feast of St Francis of Assisi. During the season we are invited to pray and act and focus on the cry of the Earth and the cry of the poor – to listen to those whose voices are less heard or silenced: to pray for those individuals, communities, species and ecosystems who are lost, and those whose livelihoods are threatened by habitat loss and climate change.

The symbol chosen for this year is the **burning bush**, which contrasts the fire of so many unnatural fires that aggravate the climate crisis; with the sign of fire as the light of the Holy Spirit that unites Christians.
