**He will be received into the church during Sung Evening Prayer for the Dead at 6.00 pm on Wednesday, 25 September.**

**His Requiem Mass will be the following day at 12 noon 26 September followed by burial at Penzance Cemetery.**

I am really pleased to let you know that today Bishop Philip Moger has been announced as the Bishop-elect of the Diocese of Plymouth.

Bishop Philip was a priest of the Diocese of Leeds for over 40 years, and for the last two years has served as the Auxiliary Bishop of Southwark Archdiocese.

I know you will join me in extending a warm welcome to Bishop Philip as he begins his new ministry as chief pastor in our Diocese.

Bishop-elect Philip will be installed as the 10th Bishop of Plymouth on the 9th November at the Cathedral Church of St Mary and St Boniface, Plymouth. Further details of this celebration will be provided in time.

I would like to personally thank you for all your help and support during my time as Diocesan Administrator. I will continue in this role, working alongside the Bishop-elect, until his installation in November.
