This Weekend. 'Pilgrims of Hope: Our journey together towards racial justice': This year marks the 30th Anniversary of the celebration of Racial Justice Sunday following the murder of Stephen Lawrence. Most Christian denominations will be joining together in prayer for an end to the great evil of 'pre-judging' people because of their race. Bishop Paul McAleenan (lead Bishop for racial justice) says: "This year, we invite the Catholic community to reflect on the journey towards racial justice – past, present and future – by asking: 'How far have we come, where are we now and what remains to be achieved?'"

At our Masses we will be marking this through our Intercessory Prayers, praying the Eucharistic Prayer for Various Needs IV and prayers for the 'Progress of Peoples'. Fr Paul will also be preaching on this theme in his homily.

Lent is coming: We need people to lead Stations of the Cross in all our Churches and to join a rota so that our Church in Penzance can be open for prayer on Monday and Thursday mornings. If you can help, please let Fr Paul know.
