Organ Donation: Donation is a gift so don't presume consent (not church organs, yours!) The Bishop responsible for healthcare, Paul Mason, has said the Government's plans to introduce "opt-out" consent for organ and tissue donation in England "undermine the concept of donation as a gift., and cross the line of what is a reasonable action for the state to take in relation to individuals within it". He added that voluntary organ donation is an intrinsic good, but donation is a gift, and implementing such policy would lead to a slippery slope in terms of how the state rules it citizens.
