**Prayer for Peace:** in Ukraine and the Holy Land invite people to join them in praying a public Rosary on Saturdays, outside the Hall for Cornwall, on Lemon Quay in Truro at 11am (inside the HFC if wet)

**General Election 2024 Thursday, 4 July.** CAFOD and SVP are inviting parishes and individuals to follow the words of the Second Vatican Council: 'to be aware of their right and duty to promote the common good by casting their votes' and by doing so to practise what Pope Francis calls the culture of encounter in which 'we find brothers and sisters, in which we can also speak with those who think differently'. To this end CAFOD and SVP suggest that we raise with candidates for the upcoming election issues of social justice which might otherwise be overlooked in the electioneering so as to stress their importance. They have suggested a list of eight different areas of questions but advise us to focus on two or three to make greater impact. Topics include plans to tackle the cost of living crisis in our area and nationally, action to address the devastating climate crisis by transitioning from fossil fuels, debt cancellation for those low-income countries who need it so that they are able to fund their essential public services, the humane treatment of people seeking asylum and sanctuary, restoration of the UK's aid budget and commitment to tackling global poverty, injustice and climate change. CAFOD and SVP have also produced a joint resource 'Year of Encounter' at <https://svp.org.uk/encounter> in which they suggest some specific questions on each of these topics. It is proposed to submit to our candidates for election questions on two or three of these issues and to have them available for anybody wishing to use at hustings meetings.
