Marina Moss, who was a parishioner here but returned to New Zealand about a year ago, has emailed about the situation in some very poverty stricken parts of the North Island and asks for **our prayers and support** too if we can manage it, through the Red Cross who have a link specifically for the New Zealand disaster. Not on the scale of Turkey/Syria, but still affecting thousands. Marina writes: **'You may have heard that Cyclone Gabrielle hit the North Island of New Zealand some days ago. The devastation seems apocalyptic. There was an earthquake too (6.3). This followed a major flood a couple of weeks ago in the region.'**
