Reception of Holy Communion under both kinds. *The Bishops' Conference feels three years on from the first Covid lockdown, a suitable time to restore the chalice would be the start of the Triduum on Maundy Thursday. It is important to remember the totality of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the Lord is received in either or both species. The choice of receiving from the chalice is for each communicant to make. They remind us too that intinction by the communicant is FORBIDDEN in England & Wales.*

I know many may feel cautious and I remain quite scrupulous about maintaining good hygiene for your altar breads to be consecrated, just as I have been in the distribution of them.

'The Peace.' Many are still wary so be aware of other peoples' feelings in exchanging the peace with physical contact.. Weekdays is better just to acknowledge, as walking around is not encouraged. Sunday's I leave to your discretion.

Gift Aid/Offerings. The new financial year begins around Easter, and Gift Aid envelopes for those who like to use them have been distributed. It is a very great help in every way that many prisoners make their offering, gift aided or not via BACS or Standing Order.

For parishioners who prefer to use ordinary green envelopes these are available in all our churches. Do ask if you can't find one. These help us ensure regular giving.
