CLARIFICATION OF DIOCESAN POLICY WITH REGARD SERVICES OF THE WORD & HOLY COMMUNION:

The Rite we use for this, was developed for Sunday use and not weekdays, in the absence of a priest. (*Bishop Christopher's revision of the policy in 2013, following instruction from Pope Benedict*), and has not changed since.

Sundays: In an emergency, if Mass cannot be celebrated because of the absence of a priest, the community should still come together for the Word & Communion. This, however must be reported to the Bishop.

Weekdays: in a church that *normally* has weekday Masses, an extended absence of a priest (over a week) can warrant the use of Rite of Word and Communion. It can be used twice a week for the duration of that absence. We are of course grateful to Canon David for continuing the normal pattern of weekday Masses where practicable.

Where the pattern in a church is that there are no weekday Masses, the people are encouraged to come together for the Office, Rosary, Stations of the Cross (in due season) & Eucharistic adoration.
