60th Anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, this weekend, also known as 'Good Shepherd Sunday.' It is an opportunity to pray for vocations and to encourage those who may be considering ordained or religious life. The Diocese of Plymouth also asks for your assistance in supporting our seminarians through their training and formation, both through prayer and financial support. At Present the **Seminarians Fund** is raising around £30K per year. It costs around £35K per year to fund a student. Furthermore by September we are hoping to have three men in major seminary and two more starting their per year. Our costs are likely to increase to around £175K.
