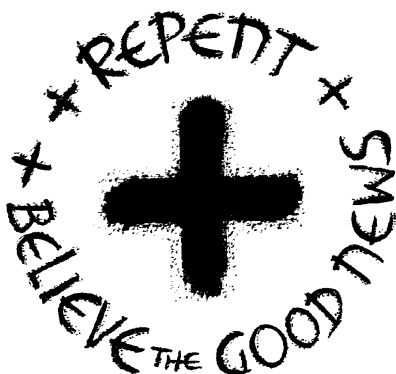

Pope Francis: Make room for God, not a love of wealth, to find your place in Heaven. Without making room for God's word in their heart, people will never be able to welcome and love all human life. The word of God helps us to open our eyes to welcome and love life, especially when it is weak and vulnerable. The text of the message is based on the parable of Dives and Lazarus in Luke: 16: 19-31. The parable calls for sincere conversion, and it provides a key to understanding what we need to do in order to attain true happiness and eternal life.

3 - Passion for Jesus.

Practical ways of moving our faith from our heads to our hearts, enabling us to live life to the full.

4 - Our Royal Inheritance

'We are children of God, and if children, then heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ'

5 - To boldly Go!

The way is open for us to come into God's presence. Christ has empowered us to carry out his work on earth, visiting the prisoners, healing the sick, giving sight to the blind, caring for the widows and orphans and spreading the Good News.

EASTER SUNDAY: 16th April – Including renewal of Baptismal Promises.
