From Father Michael – ordinary time

What an unfortunate way of describing liturgical time from Trinity Sunday until Advent! There is of course nothing ordinary about time. Time is God's great gift. "God said "Let there be light" ... and God separated the light from darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night" (Genesis 1^{3ff})

Days and night, months and years, every precious moment is a wonderful gift from God. If only we could always live in that precious present moment. If only we could be aware of the Lord's presence every second of our lives. That surely is the essence of prayer.

I am very aware of the fact that I am now roughly the same age as the Holy Father, Pope Leo. Do read his First Encyclical, "Magnifica Humanitas", a letter on the protection of the human person in the era of artificial intelligence. Every human person is a unique being created in the image and likeness of God and can never be replaced or replicated by AI generated technology. "Indeed, precisely because we experience limits – vulnerability, suffering and failure – we can recognize the inviolable dignity of every person, both our own and that of others. In this same experience, we remain capable of intuiting a fraternity greater than ourselves and of perceiving injustice as a scandal."

And then in Madrid this weekend he said, "No one can kneel before the Lord and despise their brother."

Let us give thanks to God for this great gift of papal and prophetic leadership. Thank you Pope Leo.
