**by Bishop Nicholas 11:00am Sunday the 1<sup>st</sup> November.**

No sooner do we complete a highly enjoyable Music & Arts Festival than we begin to plan for the next big occasion. The altar, the table of the Lord, is the very centre of our life as Christians. The altar symbolizes the Sacrifice of Christ. Everything we do flows from that sacrifice. Everything we are as Christians is rooted in that sacrifice. I love that bit in one of our Easter Prefaces "he brought the sacrifices of old to fulfilment in the reality of the Cross, and by commending himself to you for our salvation, showed himself the Priest, the Altar, and the Lamb of Sacrifice." Very often altars have imbedded in them relics of saints. In this instance the Oblates of Mary Immaculate have very kindly said they will provide us with a relic of St Eugene de Mazenod who actually visited this church in 1850 shortly after it was built. The imbedding of the relic will form part of the ceremony on the 1<sup>st</sup> November, All Saints Day. Doubtless, we will be forming a working party to undertake all the practical arrangements. More important though are our spiritual preparations. I will write about that in future newsletters. Meanwhile, an enormous THANK YOU to David Gridley and all our festival musicians, artists and speakers, AND THANK YOU to the intrepid band of helpers who did so much behind the scenes.

**Trinity Sunday – The Father, the son and the Holy spirit**
